Again, thank you for the invitation to participate in the process. Our team has just had sometime to review the process and all of the rules entailed in Modifying a regulation.

It appears to us that this process can be expedited by an order in Cabinet, or by a quick consensus of Parliament, on passionate grounds. Our team and many other individuals in this predicament (well over 2000 if you include those that have purchased or placed a deposit on a vehicle still in the U.S.) have suffered through many sleepless nights. The anguish, uncertainty and family disruptions caused to over the last 7 or 8 weeks is un describable. We have documented many. We would like to start preparing for the holiday season now. Is it possible to instruct the RIV to start issuing approvals today?

Your teleconferences last week surely provided you with enough feedback and assurances that you were doing the right thing. This was followed by a press release, and we did not see any organizations issuing condemning follow-up releases. Why continue to inflict this pain on Canadian citizens for another 2 or 3 weeks. If we happen to come up with other positive enhancements to the proposal over the next week, so be it.

Just recently, income splitting regulations were not approved, yet all the departments and agencies involved gave the green light to proceed many months in advance. This was an excellent and to ensure the seniors were properly informed, and that the banking and tax systems could align themselves to the new regulations.

Why can't you do this in our case? Our team might have misread the documents, and if so we would appreciate a clarification.
